

## Urgent Unmet Need: Transportation/Evacuation Routes

### Elevation of Falgout Canal Road to 10 ft.


- Approximately 4 miles
- Estimated costs of \$17.43 million

### Elevation of Lower Highway 57 to 10 ft.

- Approximately 7.1 miles
- Estimated costs of \$35.81 million
