Long Term Community Recovery Program

- Board approved the Long Term Community Recovery Funding Allocation at the February 12, 2007 meeting.
- Parishes were allocated funds based on percentages of \$200 mil CDBG for this program
- Calculations were based on a combination of two factors:
 - 1) Dollar amount of current obligated project worksheets submitted for categories C through G and any 'statewide' projects that can be associated with a particular parish, and
 - 2) Level of damage to housing units.
- Parishes below the \$150k threshold were omitted due to the cost of administering a small grant.

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PROCESS FOR RECEIVING PROGRAM FUNDS:

1. Parish must officially adopt a recovery plan that was developed with input from citizens and local community leaders and which identifies projects that speed the recovery.
2. Applicant requests approval of the parish recovery plan from the LRA.
3. Applicant fills out a brief project description for each project developed, selected and prioritized that is part of the parish's recovery plan. Each project must be eligible under the LRA's Action Plan requirements and CDBG rules. All projects do not need to be submitted at once.



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PROCESS FOR RECEIVING PROGRAM FUNDS cont'd:

4. OCD informs applicant and parish of preliminary project eligibility approval, based on Action Plan and CDBG requirement information submitted with project descriptions.
5. OCD works with applicant to complete the standard CDBG process requirements.
6. Applicant receives reimbursement of eligible project costs from OCD according to the standard CDBG process.
