The amount of FEMA dollars eligible from PA for rebuilding projects continues to increase with more than \$4.8 billion eligible, a more than \$100 million increase since April 1. Rebuilding projects for roads, utilities, parks, buildings, (C-G) now comprise almost 45% of the PA total, exceeding \$2.1b.


By comparison Hurricane Andrew had approximately 30% of its PA costs for long term rebuilding work, and the September 11th attacks had only 10%.

Payments solely for rebuilding Louisiana's infrastructure (C-G) now exceed \$525 million.

## Comparison of La. & Miss. PA programs



- The impact of Katrina in Louisiana and Mississippi now exceeds \$7 billion in PA dollars.
- The total amount eligible from PA for rebuilding and recovery in Louisiana from Katrina and Rita now exceeds \$4.8b as July 26. Payments, which now exceed \$2.4b, and have increased by more than \$400 million since the start of 2007.
